SAFEGUARDING AGREEMENT FOR CHILDREN



We are happy and thankful to you for choosing to become involved in your Parish.

To help you do your job as well as you can, you should:

- Respect God's house and all church property
- Be nice to others and treat everyone with kindness because we are all God's children
- Agree not to hurt anybody by what you say or do
- Agree to follow the rules of your group
- Not use bad language
- Never bully anyone or send threatening messages
- Arrive at the agreed time
- Talk to the person in charge if you have a problem; don't keep it to yourself
- Please don't use your phone while in church or during church activities
- Make your own arrangements with your Parents/Guardians to get to and from the Church safely
- · Let someone know if you can't attend
- Sign the register each time you attend
- Not consume alcohol, tobacco, or illegal drugs

What should I do if someone hurts me?

Tell someone you trust if you feel uncomfortable with any situation or individual - do not keep it to yourself.

How can I help to keep myself and other children safe?

If you have any worries about your role, please speak to your Parents/Guardians who will contact the Priest/Co-ordinator to discuss the matter.
